The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns hit the 2nd leg of a season-long 5-game road trip with their first-ever venture to Springfield...Reno is coming off a 4-point victory over Fort Wayne on Tuesday night...marked the Bighorns' first victory over an Eastern Conference foe this season (1-3, .250)...snapped a 2-game road losing streak for Reno...the win pushed Reno to 5-0 (1.000) when playing on Tuesdays...the Bighorns have won 2 of their last 3 games overall...through 30 games on the schedule, Reno is 1 win better this season (13-17, .433) than it was last season (12-18, .400).

All-Time Series: Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 1st all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Nicole Hoffman's Springfield Armor...the 2 clubs will meet 3 times this season (also 2/20 at SPR, 3/7 at RNO)...1 of Springfield's 3 NBA parent clubs, the New York Knicks, was a Reno parent club in the 2008-09 season.

Spreading the Wealth: Seven Bighorns registered in double figures Tuesday night at Fort Wayne...marked a season high for Reno...previously, the Bighorns had put 6 players in double figures on 5 different occasions...94 percent of Reno's scoring (88 points) on Tuesday night came from the 7 players in double figures...the Bighorns have allowed the opposition to put 7 players in double figures once this season (2/10 vs. IDA).

East Coast Swing: Tonight's game marks the 2nd of 5-straight games Reno will play against Eastern Conference foes...all 5 games will be played away from the Biggest Little City...Reno's victory on Tuesday over Fort Wayne marked the Bighorns' 1st victory of the season over an Eastern Conference team...prior to Tuesday's win, Reno fell twice in overtime to Eastern Conference foes at the D-League Showcase (DAK and ERI) and was handed a 2-point defeat at Sioux Falls on 12/18...8 of Reno's 11 games against the East this season are either road games or neutral-site games...Reno's only home contests against the East come 3/7 vs SPR and 3/26-27 vs MNE.

R-O-D-B-E-N, Son: C Rod Benson recently became the NBA D-League's all-time leading rebounder...he has 1,428 career rebounds in 166 career games in the D-League (8.6 rpg)...he has recorded 10 double-doubles this season, including 4 in his last 6 games...tied for 8th in the D-League in total double-doubles...on 12/9/07 while with Dakota, Benson set the all-time D-League record with 28 boards in a game (at SXF)...Benson has grabbed double-digit rebounds in 13 games this season, including 7 of his last 8...on Tuesday, he set a season-high with 15 boards...his previous season-high in rebounds was 14 (2x, last 2/2 at AUS).

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Bighorns Head Coach **Jay Humphries** and Armor Head Coach Dee Brown were teammates for 6 games with the Boston Celtics in the 1994-95 season...Humphries was traded by the Utah Jazz in February of 1995 to Boston in what would be the final stop of his 11-year NBA career...Brown averaged 15.6 points per game that season.

FT. WAYNE, Ind.—Seven Bighorns registered in double figures Tuesday night, as Reno held off a late Fort Wayne push in the fourth quarter to down the Mad Ants 94-90 in Allen County War Memorial Coliseum.

Fort Wayne (10-19) connected on two three-point attempts in the final 10 seconds of the game, but Reno (13-17) was able to convert each of its final four free-throw attempts to close out the victory.

Rod Benson led the Bighorns with 18 points and 15 rebounds, also registering three blocked shots. Yaroslav Korolev scored 16 points off the bench for Reno, while Will Blalock recorded three rebounds, three assists, three steals and 12 points.

Ron Howard paced the Mad Ants with a game-high 21 points. Rob Kurz finished his evening with 19 points and 12 boards.
